Questions	Answers.
Who can participate?	Anyone ages 4-18 yr. (type of schooling is irrelevant?)
When do participants pick event?	Participants choose what to participate in the on field day and at the moment each event occurs
Does Every Family need a volunteer?	YES, So that all families have the most free time to enjoy watching all their children, every family needs a volunteer. Exceptions below.
Does everyone register for a chaperon preference on the registration form?	YES, So that all families have the most free time to enjoy watching all their children, every family needs a volunteer. There is another volunteer selection where you note if you prefer to stay an age group chaperon or register for another volunteer position. I will try and meet your preference. If you have very young children, are pregnant, and/or have limitations you would fill in an age group chaperon position but then register for another position like popsicles, etc. (Please send note with check for these exceptions or volunteering for more than one thing, i.e. Field set up and Event coordinator)
Are there exceptions to the chaperon or volunteer requirement?	YES. If you are pregnant, have children 3 yr. and under, have physical limitation(s), have a multitude of participants or someone you need to care for you are excused. Please attempt to get another individual to be a helper to represent your participant(s) if possible (father, grandparent, relative, or friend). However, if you are unable to get someone to help, the other participating families would be happy to help you and your family anyway they can. (Please send note in comments on the registration form for these exceptions).
If I'm a Chaperon what are my responsibilities?	<p>You will be with a group of 2-8 other parent helpers for an age group. There will be 1-2 knowledgeable Head Chaperons to instruct their team about the responsibilities in the morning.</p> <p>As a group, everyone will decide when and in what capacity each helper is needed. You will have a very flexible opportunity to enjoy watching your children for the majority of the day. This allows parents to coordinate how they want to run their chaperon job.</p>

	<p>Two common options are everyone stick with the group all day and let each other know when you want to leave to see your other children for an event and return. Others do 2 hr. shifts or a.m. vs. p.m. shifts.</p> <p>Prior to field day you will be assigned your volunteer position and given that information. You will be able to see all other helpers for that group, (Chaperon ages group, Track, Team Crazy Game, Set-up, Registration, Decoration, Game creators, Field Clean-up etc.)</p> <p>***See Chaperon Instructions under "Instructions" tab for a detail description of responsibilities.</p>
What does Head chaperon preference mean on the registration form?	<p>If you have not been a Head Chaperon in the past you would be agreeing to come to ONE of three volunteer training meetings: Sunday 5/15 at 2 p.m., Wednesday 5/18 at 5:30 p.m. or Thursday 5/19 at 7 p.m. You would get a free matching color t-shirt of the group you're chaperoning. On the morning of field day you and another head chaperon would train the other chaperons who've been assigned to your age group and would organize everyone to contributing throughout the day so that everyone would have lots of free time to see their participants including the Head chaperon.</p>
When do I find out what my volunteer position is?	<p>Approximately 1 weeks prior to the event you will receive a series of e-mails verifying your volunteer position and your child's age group.</p>
Are drop offs allowed?	<p>Every participant MUST have someone 18 yr. or older that must be present and liable for the participant(s) the entire time.</p>
What are the Chaperon Responsibilities?	
When will t-shirts be issued?	<p>T-shirts are collected at registration the morning of field day.</p>
Are there refunds?	<p>There are no refunds at any time. Consider it a donation for the year to the TLC foundation.</p>
Can youth be placed in a different age group then their chronological age?	<p>YES, However, it is not recommended to go up or down more than one year. Remember to be fair with the competitive aspect. If a youth wants in a younger group but is very athletic they may want to decline</p>

	place ribbons. They may certainly accept Team Craze ribbons.
Can additional t-shirts be purchased?	YES, Just include your number and size in the comment section of the registration form and include an additional \$7.00/t-shirt.
